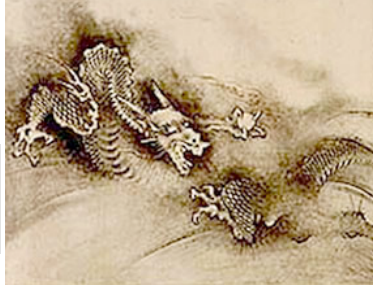

The first exhibition of Chinese paintings drawn from the MFA's permanent collection in its 125 year history.

In China, painting is one of the "Three Perfections," linked with calligraphy and poetry as the most refined of artistic endeavors. This exhibition, drawn entirely from the Museum of Fine Arts' world-renowned collection of early Chinese painting, focuses on the years in which the great traditions of Chinese painting were established, during the Tang, Song, and Yuan dynasties (the seventh through the fourteenth centuries).
